

How to get the latest update of Chrome to work with HTML5 audio.

There appears to be a new feature in the latest update of Chrome which prevents web pages from automatically playing HTML5 (and probably other) audio when the page initially loads.

I do not use Chrome, but it appears that at the moment the new 'feature' can be bypassed, or reverted if you want to.

Disclaimer

To test this, I have installed Chrome on my Windows 10 laptop, this workaround worked for me, if it breaks your Chrome browser, then I can not be held in any way responsible, as I said it worked for me, a better idea is to junk Chrome and use Firefox ;-).

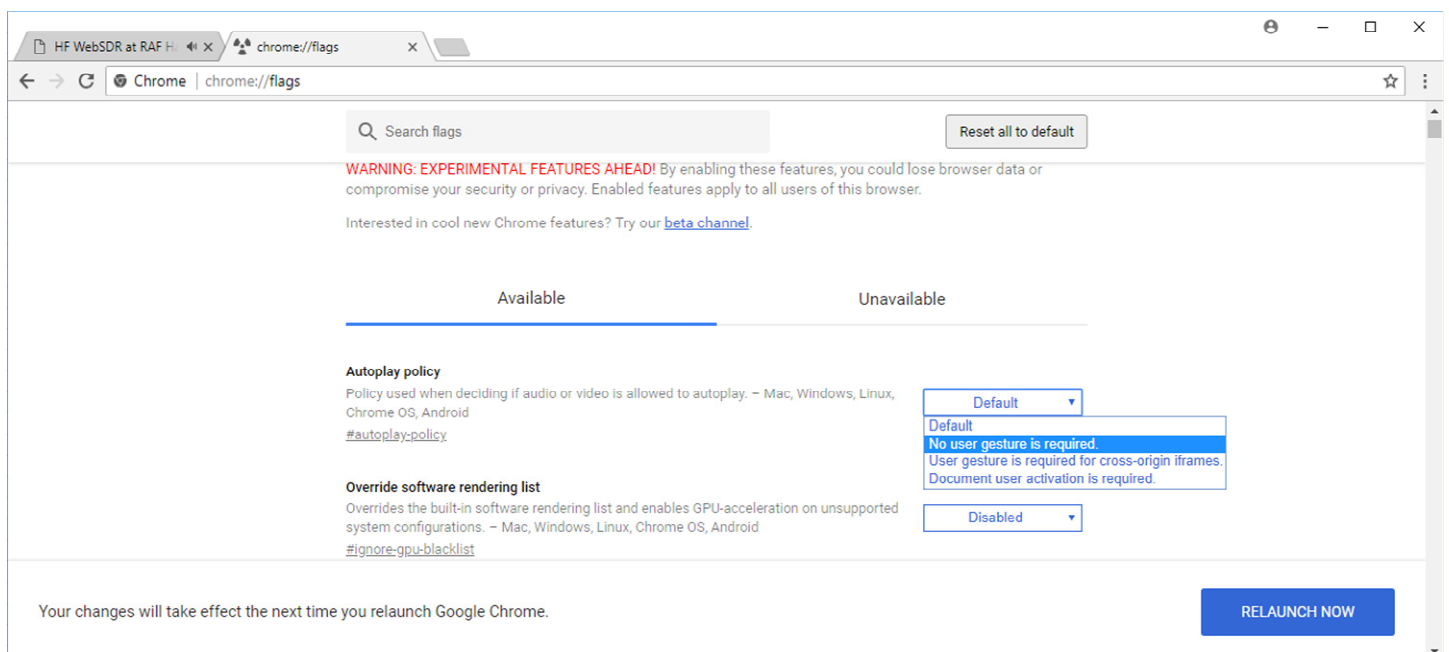
Instructions.

Open a new tab in Chrome, then in the URL field, type 'chrome:flags' without the quotes

Click the go button, then in the search box, type 'autoplay policy' again without the quotes.

In the main page area, there is a click box which will most likely be set to 'default' click in the box and select the option marked 'No User Gesture is Required'

Finally, click the 'Relaunch Now' button, chrome will restart and you should hear the hackgreensdr again.
